Joining the Live-Stream Sunday Worship Services

As previous announcements have explained, all meetings and worship services at the Danville Congregational Church, UCC will be held via Zoom video-conferencing, until further notice.

There are a couple of ways to participate in the Live-stream worship service scheduled for 10 AM on Sunday, March 22.

The best way is to join the Zoom meeting using the following link:

You can click on or type the above link into your browser, then follow the instructions to join the meeting. You may need to download the zoom app or program to your device. You may want to try this prior to the meeting to give yourself a chance to trouble shoot. There will be a practice session for this live-stream event on Saturday, March 21, at 1 PM. If you type or copy and paste that link into your browser at that time, you will be able to join the practice session, and Rev. Doug will try to work through any kinks you may have in getting on line. If you are having trouble you can call him at ***-***-**** for help. He will **NOT** be able to help with that during the live-stream event on Sunday morning

You can join that Zoom meeting using a smartphone, a tablet, or computer equipped with a built-in or separate web-cam. If your computer, tablet, or smartphone does NOT have a camera, you will still be able to participate via audio. You will even be able to listen and speak in the live-stream worship service using a regular land-line telephone by dialing the following telephone number:

and entering the following meeting ID: 695 735 968

You can also participate in a slightly more limited way by going to the church's Facebook page at 10 AM for the Live-stream event. The practice

session on Saturday, March 21 at 1 PM will also be live-streamed to Facebook Live.

This is a brand-new process for many of us, and may not be perfectly smooth, but with patience and practice, we will get there!

You may want to go to the church's website, danville-ucc.org and add your email to those receiving the monthly E-Newsletter, since that will be how we try to keep in touch with people during this time. Just click on "Newsletters" in the gray bar near the top of the website, and where it says: "If you would like to sign up for the monthly electronic version of The Parish Pulse, click here", and follow the instructions to add your email to those receiving the monthly E-newsletter.

Keep yourself healthy; reach out to connect by phone, or written messages with your neighbors, family, and friends; pray for one another; let the church office know if you or someone you know may need help or someone to talk to; take a walk outside; ... and wash your hands often.
